

Events/Inventions of the Renaissance

Materials: Paper, writing instrument, internet, book, notes

Objective: Students will collaborate to determine and justify the most important 4 or 6 events OR inventions of the Renaissance.

Procedure:

1. Students will team up
2. Students will check allowed resources and discuss the most important events or inventions from the Renaissance (1300-1550). Each student is responsible for 2 items and explanations.
3. For each item, students will write a minimum of 5 sentences explaining the choice - why is it significant? what impact did it have? why was it invented/why did it happen?
4. If you choose to work solo, you are only responsible for 2 items and paragraphs.
5. Please staple all papers together and turn them into the white bin.
